

## *Toxic and radioactive air pollution at Savannah River Site*

The new air pollution permit for SRS would allow over **13 million pounds of toxic air pollution** to be dumped into the air every year, including hydrochloric acid, arsenic, benzene, methyl ethyl ketone, mercury, lead, toluene, xylene and radioactive tritium.



The sources of air pollution include: coal-fired power plants, diesel generators, radioactive material processing plants, soil vapor extraction units, and a waste incinerator. Also, in the last ten years over one million pounds of toxic solvents have been emitted into the atmosphere by groundwater clean-up plants at SRS. This activity will continue for decades, adding many more tons of pollution to the air in the Central Savannah River Area.
